The preliminary analysis of Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) from the PvPI database reveals that the following suspected drug is associated with the ADR as given below.

1.	Piroxicam	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In the treatment of rheumatoid arthritis, osteoarthritis, ankylosing spondylitis, cervical spondylitis and other musculoskeletal disorder.</li><li>2. Anti-inflammatory agent- Indicated in the treatment of rheumatoid arthritis, ankylosing spondylitis and other musculoskeletal disorders.</li><li>3. Indicated in the treatment of musculoskeletal disorders, acute gout, pain after operative intervention following acute trauma and in primary dysmenorrhoea (12 years age or older)</li></ol>	Fixed Drug Eruption
