The preliminary analysis of Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) from the PvPI database revealed that the following suspected drug is associated with the ADR as given below.

1.	Norfloxacin	1. Antibacterial- Indicated in the treatment of acute uncomplicated/complicated chronic, recurrent urinary tract infections, including pyelonephritis, cystitis, urethritis & gonococcal infections. 2. Wide variety of infections caused by susceptible Gram +ve and Gram -ve organism including mixed infection in poultry.	Skin Hyperpigmentation
