1	Disulfiram	Antidotes, Detoxifying Agents & Drugs Used in Substance Dependence	Skin Hyperpigmentation
2	Fluconazole	For the treatment of systemic candidiasis, mucosal candidiasis, pityriasis versicolor, prevention of fungal infections in patients with malignancy.	Mouth Ulceration
