The preliminary analysis of ADRs from the PvPI database reveals that the following drugs may be associated with the risks as given below.

Sl. No	Suspected Drugs	Indication	Adverse Reactions
1	Quetiapine	For treatment of Schizophrenia and bipolar disorder	Gynaecomastia
2	Ceftriaxone	Serious infections due to sensitive bacteria, including septicaemia, pneumonia and meningitis; surgical prophylaxis; prophylaxis of meningococcal meningitis; gonorrhoea; bone and joint infection	Palpitations
