Sl. No	Suspected Drug	Indication	Adverse Drug Reaction
1	Teicoplanin	Glycopeptide antibiotic-use in serious gram +ve infection, staphylococcal infection in patients sensitive or unresponsive to penicillin and cephalsporins CAPD related peritonitis, prophylaxis in ortho paedic surgery at risk of gram +ve infections.	Toxic Epidermal Necrolysis (TEN)
