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## Drug Safety Alerts

The preliminary analysis of SUSARs from the PvPI database reveals that the following drugs are associated with the risks as given below.

Sl.No	Suspected Drugs	Indication	Adverse Reactions
1	Cabergoline	For the treatment of hyperprolactinemia and inhibition of lactation	Steven Johnson Syndrome
2	Amlodipine	Angina, hypertension, Coronary artery disease	Alopecia
3	Nitrofurantoin	Urinary tract infections; cystitis	Drug reaction with eosinophilia and systemic symptoms (DRESS syndrome)
4	Cefoperazone Sulbactam	For treatment of RTI, UTI (lower & upper), Septicemia, Meningitis, Skin & Soft tissue infection, Endometritis, Other infection of genital tract, Intra abdominal infection bone & joint infection	Acute Generalised Exanthematous Pustulosis (AGEP)
