The preliminary analysis of SUSARs from the PvPI database reveals that the following drugs are associated with the risks as given below.

Sl. No	Suspected Drugs	Indication	Adverse Reactions
1	Clomipramine	Obsessive-compulsive disorder; panic disorder	Melasma
2	Glimepiride	Type 2 diabetes mellitus	Lichenoid Drug Eruption
3	Metoprolol	Supraventricular arrhythmia, angina pectoris, hypertension, myocardial infarction; migraine prophylaxis; hyperthyroidism, heart failure	Lichenoid Drug Eruption
4	Levamisole	For the treatment of roundworm and hookworm infestations	Skin Exfoliation
